Residents consistently tell Abberton and Langenhoe parish council (ALPC) the speed of vehicles travelling through the villages is excessively high. ALPC believe the balance is currently in favour of vehicles. We are asking for Essex County Council (ECC) to implement a 20 mph speed limit where there is currently a 30 mph limit.

The first step in that process is to engage with our residents and organise a petition and present it to the Leader of Essex County Council, and our county cllr Kevin Bentley.
